PRIVACY STATEMENT

We understand the importance of protecting your privacy and we are committed to complying with the Privacy Act 1988 and the National Privacy Principles. A copy of our Privacy Policy is available on request.

How and why we collect your personal information

We collect personal information from you when you apply for membership and when you apply for or use our services. We collect it so we can:

- ◆ give you information to which you are entitled as a member; and
- ◆ supply to you, and administer, the services you require.

We also collect it so that we can give you marketing information with your consent (see below)

If your personal information is not provided

If you do not provide us with all the information on request, we may be unable to accept your application for membership or to supply to you the service that you require.

Marketing Information

We may, with your consent, use your personal information to give you information, that may be of interest to you, about the other services or products that are available from us and from other businesses with which we have relationships. Your consent will be implied unless you notify us that you do not consent to your information being used for this purpose.

You can elect to alter your consent at any time.

When we may give personal information to other organisations

Sometimes we may need to give some personal information about you to other organisations who provide services that assist us in supplying to you, or in administering the services and products that you require, or assist us in giving you the information that you are entitled to as a member. Examples of such organisations are the SA Ambulance Service, insurers, legal advisers, collection agents or conveyancers. These organisations may only use the information to the extent necessary to provide the services we require.

Sometimes we may be required to give some information about you to other organisations to comply with our legal obligations. Examples of such organisations are our auditors, our legal advisers, the Australian Taxation Office or Centrelink.

Under no circumstances will information be sold to external agencies for marketing purposes.

Your access rights, and how to contact us

The Privacy Act gives you rights to access the personal information we hold about you, and you can ask us to correct the information if it is inaccurate. More information is set out in our Privacy Policy.
